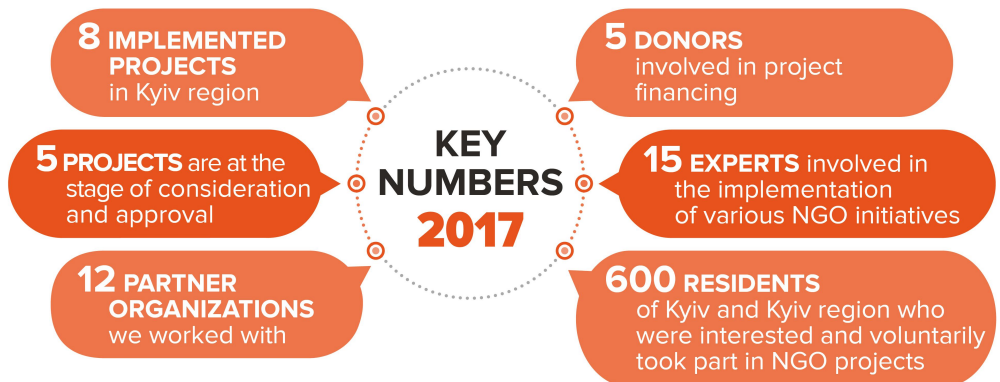

IMPLEMENTED PROJECTS:

Reconstruction of the street lighting in Bila Tserkva city

Aim: To achieve significant savings in budget funds for maintenance and electricity of the engineering network by replacing incandescent lamps with LED lamps.
Lender: Nordic Environment Finance Corporation (NEFCO).
Result: A loan agreement signed for UAH 12,000,000. International tender for selection of works executor was announced.

"Transferring Experience with Green Public Procurement in Slovakia to Ukraine"

Purpose: To spread the Slovak experience in green procurement in Ukraine and motivate state authorities to use European environmental standards.
Donor: Slovak Agency for the Development (SlovakAID).
Intermediate result: Slovakian and Ukrainian experts are involved in developing an educational on-line course for local authorities in the Kyiv region, tangent to the procurement procedure; a series of seminars and trainings are planned; the analysis of the current legislation was carried out and recommendations on the application of European acts and norms were prepared in accordance with the current Ukrainian legislation. The completion of the project is scheduled for August 2018.

Bila Tserkva preschool thermomodernization

Goal: Pre-school insulation and, consequently, savings in budget funds due to a significant reduction in the use of energy resources.
Donor: Turkish Agency for International Cooperation (TIKA).
Result: 42 energy-saving windows were installed in the pre-school № 32, stained glass windows and an entrance group were replaced, so that the comfort room for the stay and raising the temperature was established in the building.

Budget planning seminar for civil servants within TAIEX program

Objective: Conducting an educational course on medium-term budget planning for civil servants.
Partner: Technical Assistance and Information Exchange Toolkit (TAIEX).
Result: The initiative was selected and approved by the European Commission. The seminar will be held in the 2nd quarter of 2018 in Kyiv for 60 civil servants of the Kyiv region.

Implementation of the Energy Performance Contracting in Bila Tserkva

Aim: To attract investors through ESCO contracts for public buildings thermo-modernization, thereby helping to reduce the burden on the city budget by saving energy costs. A tender on ProZorro was announced regarding thermo-modernization of 18 communal buildings (7 schools, 11 pre-schools).
Result: Negotiations with the 5 largest ESCO companies of Ukraine were conducted, as a result the municipality decided to work according to the ESCO-contracts principles. A tender was announced on the The Official Resource on Public Purchasing in Ukraine. "ProZorro" regarding to thermo-modernization of 18 communal buildings (7 schools, 11 pre-schools).

Small and Medium Enterprise School (SME) for women

Aim: To train and motivate women to start and develop businesses.
Donor: United States Agency for International Development (USAID).
Result: 26 graduates, 26 business projects ready for implementation.

Bila Tserkva trolleybus park renewal

Goal: To improve urban transport infrastructure and save city resources by increasing the number of trolley buses by 30 units; major repair of the contact network of existing routes and the introduction of new routes; modernization of trolleybus depot.
Potential Donor: European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD).
Result: Negotiations with the EBRD on the attraction of funds for the project implementation have begun.

Creation of a tourist cluster in Bila Tserkva

Aim: To unite the efforts of the communities and authorities of Bila Tserkva city for the development of tourism and small business, including through the involvement of international and Ukrainian experts.
Partners: Communal Enterprise "Bila Tserkva Strategic Development Agency".
Result: A Memorandum on the creation of the tourist cluster of the city of Bila Tserkva was signed. During the year a number of cultural and entertainment events aimed at attracting a tourist audience were held. The first information stand was installed in the Alexandria Arboretum, and another 10 stands for the city prepared for installation. Touristic information center in hotel "City Park" was created. NGO "Touristic Bila Tserkva" was established as cluster headquarter.
Plans for 2018: To install new tourist signs and inform stands in the Bila Tserkva down town and Alexandria Arboretum. Continuation of marketing strategy; design and printing of corresponding printing products, organization and implementation of a number of public events (of tourist destination).
